2021	Design Standards (FADS) 2006. It was previously brought to the				
	Committee's attention by Gord that FADS 2006 has been updated to 2021.				
	As the budget season has begun in the County, Ayesha discussed with the				
	Committee that it would be great if this Committee recommended the				
	County Council adopt FADS 2021 so Public Works staff could plan the				
	2025 budget accordingly. The Committee said they would be comfortable				
	recommending to the County Council if Ayesha explains the differences				
	between FADS 2006 & 2021. This will give them a good reason to make				
	this recommendation based on facts.

National Accessibility Week & Red Shirt Day	Paula has previously brought to the Committee's attention the National Accessibility Week, May 26 th – June 1 st , 2024, and the Easter Seals Red Shirt Day campaign, which took place on May 29 th . The County didn't display its support for Red Shirt Day externally -on its website. On this, the Committee has decided to coordinate with the Communications team in January 2025 and explore the options of going from internal to external (social media) to promote such days and events and to inform the public about AAC and what they have been doing. They also suggested that the Warden make the Proclamation that National Accessibility Week and Red Shirt Day be promoted with a Red flag (accessibility). Staff from the Communication team will be invited to come and discuss this possibility with the AAC members in the January meeting.
